
EPIC TECHNO SONGS

Here's a list of the best techno songs ever:

- Lost Witness – 7 Colours (angelic Mix): lots of echo on the vocals and great chord progression/melody
- Way Out West – Mindcircus (original): soft breakbeat and melodic vocals
- Way Out West – Mindcircus (Gabriel and Dresden Club Mix) – heavy beat and awesome bassline
- ATB – Gentle Melody: beautiful synth acoustic guitar melody
- ATB – Ecstasy – the whole album is great
- ATB – Justify, ATB – Desperate Religion: both great melodic songs with good drums, lots of bass
- Cosmic Gate – London Rain, Flatline, Not Enough Time
- BT – Dreaming (DJ Tiesto Mix) – very mellow for techno but a solid beat. Excellent interlude in the second half of the song.
- Delerium - Silence (DJ Tiesto In Search of Sunrise Remix) – Deep bass on the kick drum, great subwoofer material – vocals are excellent as well
- Kamaya Painters – The Collected Works – great album with some of Tiesto's earliest work on it.
- Organic Audio – Nurega – amazing bassline and some good riffs. Worth checking out.
- BT – Satellite – more chillout music than techno but one of my favorite songs ever. Acoustic guitar, vocals and breakbeat.
- Deadmau5 – The Veldt [8 Minute Edit] – Vocal trance at its best
- Andain – Beautiful Things (Gabriel & Dresden Unplugged Mix) – Excellent vocals and a sparse but effective melody/bass combo.
- Jes – Disconnect – great album from Jes, who worked quite a bit with Tiesto on various singles. Not all of the songs on this album are new (if you already have a lot of Tiesto's work), but it's a good listen from start to finish.
- Tiesto - Pretty much everything he's ever made ranges from decent to awesome (except, perhaps, Kaleidoscope). In particular, Magik Six, In Search of Sunrise 3 and 6, Just Be, In My Memory, and Elements of Life are great albums.
